Know your weaknesses. Know your destination. Collect metrics.

Key Ingredient #1 Good, technical managers.

Aim to solve problems previously addressing misconceptions.

Be prepared to embrace software development.

Attack rigid change management with aggressive testing.

Embrace failure.

Programmatically enhance communication between silos.

If that can't be done, fail back to acceptable (but still improved) defaults.

Keep metrics!

Streamline handovers between teams using software tooling.

Prioritise bug fixes and preventing downtime.

Encourage use of software development ideologies e.g. Agile/Scrum/Kanban.

Give regular demos.

Use CI tools for testing and visualisation.

Break down work into small, modular units.

Know when to cede territory to the "enterprise solution".

APIS. Make them, use them.

Version your APIs.
